Uses

Liquid Nails® Landscape is suitable for use on materials such as stone, concrete, capstones, terracotta and timber and it is ideal for landscaping projects such as:

- Stabilising stone & interlocking masonry retaining walls
- Bonding pavers to concrete
- Bonding capstones to walls
- Repairing rockeries
- Sealing between treated pine logs to reduce soil loss
- Stabilising loose stone steps.

Surface Preparation

- Ensure the surface is sound, dry and free from oil, grease and loose powdery material (if necessary, use mineral turpentine to clean surface and allow to dry).
- Cut cartridge tip, fit nozzle and cut nozzle to a suitable size opening (approximately 5mm).
- Apply using caulking gun

Directions for Use

1. Apply 'dobs' or 'beads' of adhesive of appropriate thickness to ensure sufficient contact and spread between both surfaces. (To minimise 'squeeze out' apply at least 12mm in from edges).
2. Immediately bring surfaces together before product skins (within 5 minutes) and apply sufficient pressure to spread adhesive between both surfaces
3. Do not wipe excess 'squeeze out'. Wait until product cures and remove by trimming with a sharp blade but avoid cutting into bond.
4. Leave undisturbed until adhesive cures sufficiently. Do not allow traffic on stairs or use walls for at least 24 hours.

Note

- Not for soft or crumbly materials.
- If repositioning materials, fresh adhesive must be applied to achieve bonding.
- Do not use as the sole bonding agent for structural bonding

Tips

Spilt or smeared adhesive is best left to cure and then remove by abrasion.

Clean Up

Uncured product may be removed with mineral turpentine. Cured product can be removed with the help of Selleys Silicone Remover or by mechanical action.

Storage

- Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place and out of direct sunlight
- Store away from foodstuffs.

Limitations

- Not for permanent water immersion
- Cannot be painted over.
