DAVID GRAYS VEGETABLE DERRIS DUST

HOW TO USE: DO NOT apply if rain is imminent.

| Strawberries Vegetables Vines | Aphids and Caterpillars | Apply after watering to upper and lower surfaces of leaves, on stems, flowers and edible parts. Repeat at 10-14 day intervals |

NOT TO BE USED FOR ANY PURPOSE OR IN ANY MANNER CONTRARY TO THIS LABEL UNLESS AUTHORISED.

DO NOT PICK FOOD CROPS FOR ONE DAY AFTER DUSTING.

CAUTION: DO NOT allow chemical containers or dust to get into drains, sewers, streams or ponds. Cover or remove fish ponds or fish bowls before applying dust.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in the closed original container in a cool, dry place out of the reach of children. Do not store in direct sunlight. Dispose of empty container by wrapping in paper, placing in a plastic bag and putting in garbage.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS: May irritate the eyes and skin. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Wash hands after use.
